



2011 NON-RESIDENT SPRING WILD TURKEY PERMIT APPLICATION

APPLICATION DATES - Applications received prior to a deadline date will be processed with mail received on that deadline date.

SECOND LOTTERY - Applications from non-residents and anyone that does not have a permit will be accepted through Jan. 11.

THIRD LOTTERY - Applications from anyone that does not have a permit or has one permit will be accepted through Feb. 9.

RANDOM DAILY DRAWINGS - Anyone that does not have a permit or has one or two permits may apply for the first random daily drawing from applications received prior to and including March 9.

APPLICATION INFORMATION

- In-person and mail applications will receive equal treatment.
Permits are not transferable and no refunds will be made unless your county, hunt area or season choices are not available.
A permit is valid for only ONE season.
The fee for each permit is \$125. You must enclose an individual check or money order with your application. Do not send cash.
A permit allows the holder to hunt with either a shotgun or bow and arrow.
Non-resident landowners who obtain a permit to hunt their own property (or a lottery permit) may apply for a second permit (\$125) in the February 9 third lottery, and a third permit (\$125) in the March 9 random daily drawing, subject to availability.
It shall be unlawful to: Submit applications before the second lottery for more than one permit for the same person; submit applications before the third lottery for more than two permits for the same person; receive more than three permits for the spring turkey season.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

- You must use an official 2011 Department of Natural Resources Non-Resident Spring Wild Turkey Permit application form.
Applicants submitting applications within three weeks of the season will not be guaranteed receipt of permit by start of season.

- 1 You must check ONE BOX ONLY to indicate which application period you are applying for.
2 HUNT LOCATION & SEASON CHOICES. There are ten rows of boxes to allow you to make up to ten choices of combined locations and seasons.
3 Your social security number or DNR Direct customer number.
4 Your name and complete address.
5 Your date of birth (month, day, year).
6 Child support certification/applicant's signature/phone number.
7 GROUP HUNT. This section must be completed by those applicants who intend to hunt as a group.

APPLICATION RETURN ADDRESS. Applications must be returned to the Springfield Permit Office, either via mail or in person. See address on other side.

HUNTING ZONES

- There are north and south turkey hunting zones WITH DIFFERENT SEASON DATES in each zone. Special Hunt area permits are not valid anywhere else in the county.
Northern Zone includes that portion of Illinois north of Crawford, Jasper, Effingham, Fayette, Bond, and Madison Counties. Southern Zone includes the remainder of the state.

NORTHERN ZONE SEASON DATES, OPEN COUNTIES & SPECIAL HUNT AREAS
