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**APPLICATION DATES**

**FIRST LOTTERY** - Applications from Illinois residents will be accepted from the date upon which they become available through April 30.

**SECOND LOTTERY** - Applications from non-residents and anyone that does not have a permit will be accepted through June 30.

**THIRD LOTTERY** - Applications for the Third Lottery will be accepted through August 18. Anyone (regardless of other deer permits they may have) may apply for one or more permits in this lottery.

**OVER THE COUNTER SALES** - Any remaining permits will be available over-the-counter from license vendors beginning October 17 on a first come, first serve basis. Permits will be sold until quotas are exhausted, or until the close of the firearm deer season, whichever occurs first. Individuals can purchase one or more permits during this period, subject to availability.

**GROUP HUNT INFORMATION**

Up to six individuals may apply to hunt as a group. All individuals in the group must pre-select a group leader and each application for the group MUST have IDENTICAL choices for the application period, hunt locations & seasons, and group leader information. Illinois residents are given preference for permits allocated in lotteries, therefore groups containing both resident and non-resident applicants will be treated as non-resident applications.

## APPLICATION INFORMATION

- Applications will be rejected, fees forfeited and permits revoked if you receive or attempt to receive more than one either-sex and/or one bonus antlerless-only FIREARM permit before June 30. You can apply in both the firearm and muzzle-loader-only lotteries.
- Landowners or tenants who apply for or receive Free Property Only Hunting Firearm Deer Permits cannot apply in the firearm first or second lotteries, but may apply in the third lottery.
- Permits are not transferable and no refunds will be made unless your county, hunt area or season choices are not available.

**\*\*\* All counties are open to firearm deer hunting except Cook, DuPage, Lake (EXCEPT Chain O' Lakes State Park) and that portion of Kane county east of State Route 47. \*\*\***

## Special Hunt Areas

Special hunts held on federal or state lands are regulated by the agency which manages the property. Some of these areas are included in the lotteries (see list below). If you wish to apply for a permit to hunt one of these areas, enter the appropriate code from the list below. Special Hunt Area permits are not valid anywhere else in the county. County permits are not valid for the Special Hunt Areas listed on this application.

## PREFERENCE SYSTEM

In order to be eligible for preference, an applicant for the first firearm lottery must check the Second Season Option box on the application, indicating that he/she will accept a second season permit if there are no remaining full season permits. An applicant who then receives an either-sex second season permit in the first lottery, or who is rejected, is eligible for preference in that county the next year. This does not apply to special hunt areas and bonus antlerless-only permits.

## OTHER HUNT AREAS

There are other areas that have local drawings for permits from county permit holders. Hunters for these areas must first acquire a permit for the county where the area is located. - (8) Youth hunters must be accompanied by a non-hunting parent or legal guardian.
- (9) Standby permits available on site. Permit holder must check-in at site by 5am or permit not valid for day.
- (10) LSPMOU permits are only valid for hunting state or federal lands (open to hunting) associated with Lake Shelbyville in Moultrie County.
- (11) LSPSHE permits are only valid for hunting state or federal lands (open to hunting) associated with Lake Shelbyville in Shelby County. Wolf Creek State Park is a separate special hunt area.
- (12) No hunting in the controlled pheasant hunting area.
- (13) Hunters must take an antlerless deer during the current year firearm season on site before they can purchase an either-sex permit.
- (14) Attendance mandatory at pre-season lottery for shooting site selection.
- (15) For Corps of Engineers managed lands not managed by IDNR, contact COE, Lake Shelbyville office for specific deer hunting policy.
- (16) Ash Swale Waterfowl Rest Area closed to deer hunting during waterfowl hunting seasons.

- (1) Only antlerless deer or antlered deer having at least four points on one side may be harvested.
- (2) An additional site hunting pass is required at the site; wheelchair accessible blinds are available by reservation. No handguns allowed.
- (3) Excludes Wolf Creek State Park.—Not used; included in "11."
- (4) Only antlerless deer or antlered deer having at least five points on one side may be harvested.
- (5) Disabled hunters must possess a Class P2A disability card and have a non-hunting helper on the day of the hunt.
- (6) Applicants must not have reached their 18th birthday, have completed a State-approved Hunter Education course and have a hunting license, unless exempt, by the start of the Youth hunt dates.
- (7) Youth hunters must be accompanied by a hunting or non-hunting parent or legal guardian; supervisors that hunt may only take antlerless deer.
